

Built in 2014, the **Avalon Siem Reap** was specifically designed to offer the best cruise experience on the Mekong. She has been meticulously crafted to offer all the modern features you expect, yet she retains the colonial charm so fitting to Vietnam and Cambodia. With her ultra-shallow draft, the **Avalon Siem Reap** can penetrate remote areas, and enable real cultural exchanges between the traveller and the inhabitants of the Mekong.

Sailing on an **Avalon Cruise** is essentially an **outdoor experience**, and the atmosphere is informal and relaxed. The public spaces never feel congested, with plenty of plush seating in the Panorama Lounge and the top-deck Observation Lounge, plus choice spots to relax and take in the view.

The 18 air-conditioned suites (cabins) all face out from the ship and are all comfortable and roomy – with king-size or share-twin beds ... large private bathrooms ... ample storage ... and huge windows that slide across to form an open-air balcony with unparalleled river views.
